Gen. J.M.C. VI - Mary Nance (b.30 May 1770 - d.1 Jan.1842, Mecklenburg, Va.) md. Henry Co., Va. Jesse Crouch (b.25 Apr,1760, Stratford Co., Va. - d.22 Dec.1841), son of John and Sarah "Barbee" (Barbary) Crouch. Both buried at Buffalo Ridge Baptist Church, Washington Co., Tenn. This church was organized in 1779 and is one of the oldest Baptist churches in Tennessee, if not the oldest. The Sinking Creek Baptist Church, also in Washington Co., is supposedly the older by some 15 years. The exact date of the Crouch family's arrival is not known, but some records indicate that Jesse Crouch gave the land that the Buffalo Church was built on. Henry Co., Va. Records indicate Jesse to be living in Henry Co., Va. near 1795. It is the writer's belief that Jesse Crouch's family was in Tenn, by 1779, His Revolutionary War records indicate he served in Virginia. It appears he claimed a Virginia bride, remained in Henry Co. and returned to Tennessee about 1795.
