Allen was quite active in settling estate of brother Bird, died 1815, and Isaac, 1819, (see Rutherford Co, records) Made a will 18 Feb,1836, Probated 9 May 1836, Vol, 9, p,327. Names following heirs: wife Elizabeth. son 1) Allen Jr,; daughters 2) Susan and 3) Emeline Nance; married daughters 4) America Clark, 5) Elin Woodley, 6) Nancy Baker, 7) Polly Dement, 8) June (Jane?) (Skipper) Nance (b,18 Feb.1795, Henry Co., Va.) 1st md. 13 Dec.1813, Henry Co., Polly King, daughter of George King, 2nd md, 20 Dec . 1816 Ellinor "Simms" Jennings, a widow, and daughter of Jane "Nance" and Ignatious Simms, Peyton S,'s second cousin, lived in Henry Co. until 1828, was a Baptist minister. in Kentucky in 1837, performed marriage in Caldwell Co., Ky., in 1840, Trigg Co., Ky, Census, also 1850 census.
