In Memory of Patrick C. Caldwell, who was born March 10, 1801 and died Nov, 22, 1855. He graduated South Carolina College in 1820 and later preparing himself for the practice of law, he followed that profession for several years. He represented his native district at different times in both branches of the State Legislature and he also represented the State in the 27th U. S. Congress.

In Memory of Henry Priestly Pratt, who was born June 7th, 1825, and died Oct. 26th, 1847, He volunteered in Company L, raised in the District under Capt. Williams for the Mexican War, and **on** the 13th of Jan.1847 he left his home and friends destined to return no more. He fell prey to a disease in a strange land and an enemy's country, and died in a Military
