- Gen. VIII - Isabella, md. 2nd William Miner

- Gen. XI - Thomas Miner or Minor (1608-1680 or 90) came from England in the Arabella 1630; at Salem, Mass, 1630; founder of the church at Charlestown, Mass. 1632; founder of Pequot (New London), Conn, 1645 and Deputy to the General Court 1650-51; founder of Stonington, Conn. 1663 or 54 and Deputy to the General Court between 1665-69; Colonia Wars (Sergt.1649; Lieut. and Capt., King Philip's War; Chief Military Officer at Mystic 1665); m. Grace Palmer, daughter of Walter Palmer who came from England to Salem, Mass. in 1628. (see Gen. IX, The West Family)
