

DESCENDANTS OF CLOVIS THE RIPARIAN AND CHARLEMAGNE

1. Childebert (24-2), King of Cologne, liv. 450, son of Clovis the Riparian, Frankish King of Cologne, liv. 420, a kinsman of Clovis I.
2. The first three or four generations of this pedigree are open to doubt. Probably no line back to either Clovis the Riparian or Clovis I (d. 511), should be accepted other than tentatively; absolute proof is lacking, though a reasonable degree of certainty may exist.
2. Siegbert the Lame, King of Cologne; murdered 509.
3. Cloderic the Parricide (24-4), King of Cologne, murdered 509; m. a kinswoman of St. Clothilde (the Burgundian queen of Clovis I, King of the Salle Franks).
4. Blithilde, m. Ansbertus (73-5), the Gallo-Roman Senator.
5. Erchenaud (bro. of Modericus, Bishop of Arisltum, 578).
6. Leuthanus, m. Gerberga, dau. of Duke Ricomer of the Burgundian House.
7. A daughter, in. Ansoud.
8. Sigrada (mother of Didon, Bishop of Poitiers, 656-670).
9. Count Warinus, d. 677 (bro. of St. Leger, d. 677, Bishop of Autun); m. Kunsa, a sister of Basin, Bishop of Treves. (14B-9, 74-1)
10. Lambert (bro. or brother-in-law of St. Lievin, Bishop of Treves, 698-704).
11. N. (bro. of Robert, Duke of Hesbaye, 722-742).
12. Robert, m. Williawinda, dau. of Alleaume.
13. N. (bro. of Thurimbert, fl. 770, and Cancor, Count in the Rheingau, 784-782).
14. Alleaume, fl. 785 (bro. of Humbert, Count of Worms, 778).
15. N, (bro. of Guy, Marquis of Brittany, 799-834, and of Robert, Count of Worms, 814-822).
16. Witichin, Count of Soissons, 835-844; m. (1) a sister of Elides, Count of Orleans, and grand-niece of Hildegarde, wife of the Emperor Charlemagne.
17. Robert the Strong, Count of Paris, Marquis of Neustria, d. 866; m. (2) Adelaide (74-6), of Alsace.
18. Robert I, d. 15 June 923, Duke of France, Marquis of Neustria, King of the West Franks; m. (1) Adele; m. (2) Beatrix, parentage unknown.
19. Liegard, dau. by the first wife; m. Herbert II (14B-18, 62-18), d. 943, Count of Vermandois and Troyes.
20. Aliz de Vermandois, d. 960; m. 943, Arnold I (66-18), the Old, d. 27 Mar. 963, Count of Flanders.
