The following is the deposition of Mr. John Nance of Mecklenburg County Virginia, formerly of Brunswick County--

Question 1<sup>st</sup> Mr. John Nance were you acquainted with Griffin Nash in Virginia,

Answer – I was --

2<sup>nd</sup> Were you in the A revolutionary War?

Answer – I was attending to the Commissary by driving Beeves and Hogs to the Army and delivering them to Mr. Lamb for the use of the Army--

3<sup>rd</sup> do you know any thing of Griffin Nash being in the Revolutionary War?

Answer – I do – he was in actual service three months.

4<sup>th</sup> what day he was then the War?

Answer – I think in 1781 before the surrender of Cornwallis --

North Carolina, Stanley County

Personally appeared before me Henry Davis one of the acting Justices of the peace in and for said County John Nance and being sworn in due form of law Deposeth as above stated, Sworn to before me this first day of April 1844.
